Predicted Log will have a new look this year. We have moved from Smith Mountain Lake to the coast. Sounds like lots of fun!!

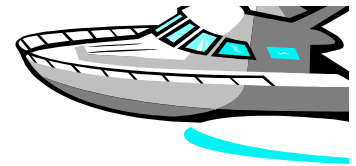
